Special Group Tour Terms and Conditions

Please read the following information carefully. Your campus visit request will be complete once you submit the online request form at admissions.calpoly.edu/visit/group_tours.

1. Student to chaperone ratio should be at least 20:1.
2. Groups traveling to campus should plan to arrive at least 45 minutes prior to their scheduled tour/presentation time. Current volunteer students lead our campus tours and are available only during the arranged tour time. Student volunteers cannot wait for late tour groups any longer than 15 minutes after the appointed tour time due to class commitments. Groups arriving any more than 15 minutes late to a tour will result in guided tour cancellation.
3. Group tours are 90-minute walking tours and the length of the tour may not be adjusted to accommodate late arriving groups or tour groups that wish to finish early.
4. Individual group members must remain orderly at all times. Adult chaperones are required to stay with each tour group at all times and monitor student behavior. Inappropriate or disrespectful comments or actions will not be tolerated, and may result in immediate termination of the visit. Poly Rep tour guides reserve the right to stop a tour at any time if disorderly or unsafe conduct occurs.
5. Cal Poly and its representatives reserve the right to terminate the tour and/or ask any individual or group to leave campus at any time due to inappropriate behavior as determined by Cal Poly at its sole discretion.
